

HOW TO VOTE FOR A Bullet Train! in the Senate & House of Reps



PUT A '1' IN THE BULLET TRAIN FOR AUSTRALIA column 'E'

You will find our column almost smack bang in the middle of the Senate ballot paper

Put a number '1' in the box labelled 'E - BULLET TRAIN FOR AUSTRALIA' above the line.

If you vote above the line, you do not need to number any other box.

Senate

(Massive white ballot paper)

NO NEED TO FILL IN THIS PART

TO CHOOSE YOUR OWN PREFERENCES IN THE SENATE, VOTE BELOW THE LINE

To vote below the line number EVERY box below the line, starting with Bullet Train candidates first. Do not put any numbers above the thick black line.

(Small green ballot paper)
