

HOW TO VOTE FOR A Bullet Train! in the Senate & House of Reps



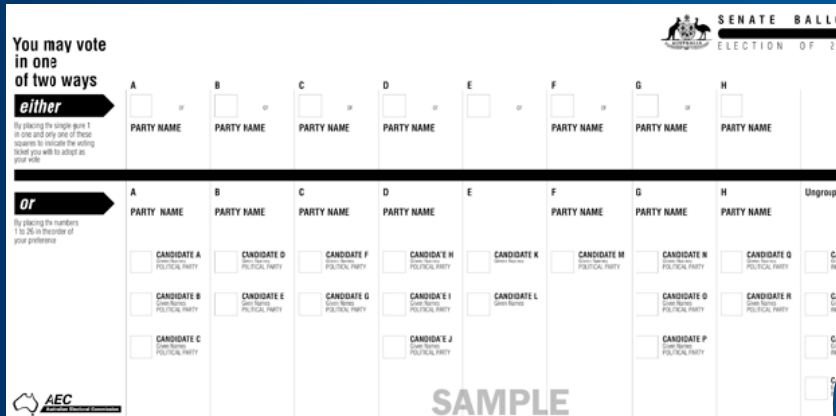
You will find our column almost smack bang in the middle of the Senate ballot paper
