

HOW TO VOTE FOR A Bullet Train! in the Senate & House of Reps



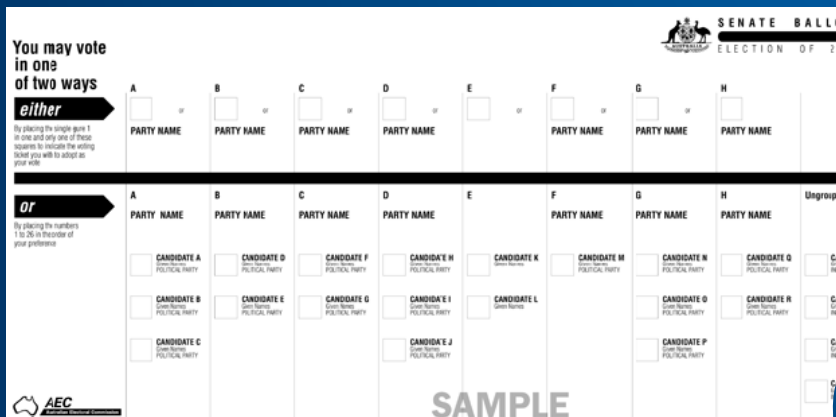
You will find our column almost smack bang in the middle of the Senate ballot paper

Put a number '1' in the box labelled 'X - BULLET TRAIN FOR AUSTRALIA' above the line.

If you vote above the line, you do not need to number any other box.
